

Lobuche Peak Climbing



Lobuche Peak is popular peak in Nepal for all kinds of climbers. This peak is 6119 meters high from sea level. It has existed two distinct summits to Lobuche Peak which called Lobuche east peak (6119 m.) and Lobuche west peak (6145 m).

Although they are connected by a continuous ridge there is a sharp gap and a considerable distance between them. Lobuche east is an attractive summit with existing routes and new opportunities. Lobuche east is one of the hardest of the trekking peaks that commercial groups attempt.

Lobuche peak is an attractive summit, offering a variety of existing routes and wide scope for new lines. Seen from near Pheriche, the dark triangle of its rocky east face rises above the moraines of the Khumbu Glacier to and icy skyline. This skyline forms the south ridges, the junction of the east faces with the glaciated south west face and the line of the normal route of ascent.

Itinerary:

Day 01

Kathmandu Arrival

Our representative picks you up at airport and transfer to Hotel.

Day 02

Kathmandu City Tour

Tour Guide will be taken you some historical and cultural places for half day city tour in Kathmandu valley and you will brief about Lobuche peak climbing in the afternoon at our office.

Day 03

Fly to Lukla and trek to Phakding.

Early morning transfer to airport from hotel with trekking guide and meet with other crews at Lukla and trek to Phakding.

Day 04

Trek from Phakding to Namche Bazaar

After breakfast, slowly walk up to Namche. During this trekking day you will see beautiful views of Mount Everest, Thamserku Peak and Lhotse Himal.

Day 05

Trekking Rest in Namche Bazaar

This is rest day in Namche Bazaar for acclimatization. you walk around Namche Bazaar and also trekking guide will take you some good excursion of traditional Sherpa villages as Khumjung or Thame.

Day 06

Namche to Phorche Thanga

After breakfast, walk up to Phorche Thanga, during this walking day, you can visit Tengboche Monastery. Also can see a nice view of Himalayan ranges as Thamserku, Kang Taiga and Taboche etc.

Day 07

Phorche Thanga to Dole to Machhermo

This day you will walk along with Rhododendrons forests give way to junipers and tall conifers. After Dole the landscape gets rocky and Mount Cho Oyu will be seen.

Day 08

Trekking from Machhermo to Gokyo

This day we follow the immense frontal moraine of the Ngozumpa glacier to the Gokyo lakes. Then climb up to discover one by one those emerald drops lost into black rocks and snow.

Day 09

Ascent to Gokyo Peak

This day you will climb up small peak Gokyo Peak 5480 meters and during the tiem, you will feel a breathtaking 360 ° view with Lhotse, Everest, Makalu, Cho Oyu, four of the fourteen 8000 m high on earth, dominating the myriad lesser peaks.

Day 10

Trekking from Gokyo to Nyimagawa

This trekking day, you will cross through moraines of the terminal spit of Ngojumpa glacier. From Thagna, climb up through gentle and grassy slopes to the foot of the Cho La.

Day 11

Trekking from Nyimagawa to Cho La pass to Dzongla

This trekking day is a bit easy than other day, you will slowly steep up trail goes through blocks of rocks. After the Cho La pass, we shortly cross an easy segment of the glacier then descend towards Dzongla.

Day 12

Trekking around Dzongla Base Camp

From Dzonla Base Camp is situated beside a lake, we can enjoy stunning vistas of the Ama Dablam and the Taweche.

Day 13

Base Camp to High Camp

Through snowy slopes, we step onto a ridge overhanging the Khumbu and Lobuche glaciers. Setting up fixed ropes is sometimes necessary (slopes with a gradient about 45 to 50 degrees).

Day 14

Day to ascent Lobuche Peak

Lobuche Peak ascent (6119 m) and backwards to High Camp in 8 h. Steady progress on the final ridge towards the summit, we can come across few crevasses.

Day 15

High Camp to Pheriche

It takes 6 hours from trek to Pheriche from High camp. You will stay at Pheriche after completing your peak climbing.

Day 16

Trekking from Pheriche to Tengboche

The largest and most active monastery of Khumbu is located at Tengpoche. You will visit there too.

Day 17

Trekking from Tengboche to Namche Bazaar

This day, you will walk with steep down route to Namche and stay there.

Day 18

Trekking from Namche to Lukla

This route also steep down which is already experienced, so you will direct walk down to Lukla.

Day 19

Fly from Lukla to Kathmandu

This day you will fly from Lukla to Kathmandu and transfer to Hotel.

Day 20

Rest day in Kathmandu

After long trekking and challenging peak climbing, you will take rest a day or shopping for family, friends and relatives etc.

Day 21

Departure from Kathmandu

We will see you off from Hotel to your onward destination.

Cost Include:

- Airport / Hotel / Airport pick up & drop off transfer by car / Van.
- Hotel accommodation with breakfast double bed sharing basis in Kathmandu.
- Half Day Kathmandu city/sightseeing tour.
- Meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) with Tea & coffee and hot water during the trek.
- Lddge or Guest HOUse accommodation on sharing basis during the trek and Tented accommodation in climbing period.
- Trekking Guide and Porter with experienced, helpful and friendly persons.
- Experience and Professional Climbing Guide with cook, kitchen helper during climbing period.
- Salary, equipment, their food and accommodation and Insurance for Guide, Porter and Climbing Guide.

Cost exclude:

- Any meals in Kathmandu and other than breakfast.
- Travel insurance.
- International air fare to and from Nepal.
- Nepal Tourist Visa fees.
- Items and expenses of personal nature.
- Any kind of alcoholic drinks, cold drinks, snacks, laundry, phone call, internet.
- Sleeping Bag and Down Jacket and Personal Trekking and Climbing Equipment.
- Emergency Evacuation (Helicopter Rescue).
- Any costs which arise due to a change of the itinerary, because of landslides, domestic flight delays, political disturbance, and strikes etc.
- Any other costs whatsoever, that is not mentioned in the cost included.
- Horse renting and additional porters during the trek.
- Climbing Gears Full Set(Ropes, Plastic Boot, Ice- Axe, Safety belt, Caravinas, Gaiters, Jumar, 8 fingers & all necessary Equipments for Climbing
- Tips for guide, porters, driverTipping is expected but it is not mandatory.
